HEAD COACH PRYOR ORSER

The 2007-08 season will mark Pryor Orser's seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at CSM.

Last winter, CSM compiled a 14-13 overall record and posted an 8-11 mark in the RMAC. Three Orediggers earned recognition on the All-RMAC teams, including Ian Elseth (Second Team All-East Division), Kyle Pape (Second Team All-East Division) and Franklin Ryk (Honorable Mention All-East Division).

Orser's previous coaching experience includes a four-year stint at Northwest College (Wyoming), where he served as the head coach of the women's program and also as an assistant with the men's team. Also a physical education instructor at Northwest, Orser's women compiled a program-record 22 victories during his fourth and final season, marking a 20-game improvement from his first year at the helm.

In addition to spending two seasons as the assistant men's basketball coach and the assistant S.I.D. at Carroll College in Helena, Montana, Orser served for three years as the assistant coach for the Montana State University - Billings men's basketball team.

A graduate of Gardiner High School in Gardiner, Montana, Orser was selected as the Class C State MVP as a senior in 1985. Orser lettered all four years at MSU - Billings, leading the Yellowjackets to a pair of NCAA Division II tournament appearances and a trip to the 1986-87 NCAA Division II Final Four. MSU - Billings won more than 80 games during Orser's collegiate career. Following his senior season, Orser garnered Honorable Mention All-Conference accolades.

In the spring of 2005, *Westword Newspaper* named Orser's Basketball Camps as the Best Place for Young Hoops Hotshots in its annual Best of Denver issue. Orser's camps have grown each year and have attracted as many as 140 players during a single week.

Orser received his bachelor's degree in Business Administration - Finance with minors in Economics and History from Eastern Montana College in 1990 before earning his master's in Education from Montana State University - Billings (1995).

OREDIGGER GAME NOTES

Next week: Following this week's home games against Colorado Christian University (Friday, Jan. 18th at 8:00 p.m.) and Metro State (Saturday, Jan. 19th at 8:00 p.m.) at Lockridge Arena, CSM will travel to Chadron State (Thursday, Jan. 24th) and Nebraska - Kearney (Saturday, Jan. 26th).

Grizzlies upend Mines, 82-69: Adams State defeated CSM by the score of 82-69 last Friday, Jan. 11th, in Alamosa. **Ben Mohr** (12-of-15 FT) and **Kyle Pape** registered 20 points apiece for the Orediggers, who trailed by 10 (41-31) at the half. **Drew Hoffman** (5-of-9 FG) added 12 points as Mines dropped to 9-8 overall (2-5 RMAC).

Orediggers defeat CSU - Pueblo, 66-61: Mines defeated CSU - Pueblo by the score of 66-61 last Thursday, Jan. 10th, in Pueblo. The Orediggers were led by **Ben Mohr** (10-of-13 FT), who tallied a team-high 20 points. Mohr also accounted for five rebounds and four assists while **Kyle Pape** (8-of-8 FT, five rebounds, three assists) and **Chad Frieauf** (5-of-8 FG, 5-of-6 FT, five rebounds) concluded the night with 15 points apiece. CSM, which converted on 26-of-30 free throw attempts as a team, improved to 9-7 overall (2-4 RMAC).

Flyin' Hawaiian: **Kyle Pape** is currently ranked second in the RMAC in scoring with 18.7 ppg. Pape has reached the 20-point plateau in 11 of 17 games this season and has amassed double figures in scoring in all but two games. Even more, Pape is currently ranked fourth in the RMAC in free throw % (.839; 73-of-87). Selected to the 2007-08 Pre-Season All-RMAC East Division Team, Pape was the only Oredigger to start all 27 games during his sophomore campaign in 2006-07. Pape, who earned Second Team All-RMAC East Division accolades last winter, garnered RMAC Freshman of the Year and RMAC Shootout All-Tournament honors in 2005-06.

Big Ben: Through 17 games, **Ben Mohr** is currently ranked first in the RMAC in rebounding (9.6 rpg). Mohr, who has registered five double-doubles and has reached double figures in scoring in 12 contests, is averaging a team-second-best 14.0 points per game. Mohr is also ranked fifth in the RMAC in field goal % (.614; 89-of-145), fifth in assists (4.2 apg) and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.58). Mohr currently leads CSM in blocked shots (nine) and steals (17). Selected as the RMAC Freshman of the Year in 2004-05, Mohr earned Academic All-RMAC recognition last winter.

Providing assistance: After compiling team-second-best numbers in assists (62) and steals (24) in 2006-07, **Casey O'Hayre** is averaging a team-second-best 2.4 assists per game this winter. In fact, O'Hayre has dished out five assists on four occasions in 2007-08. O'Hayre, who played in all 27 games last year, was an Academic All-RMAC performer in the classroom as a sophomore.

Case file: **Jacob Case** is averaging 7.1 ppg and 2.7 rpg through CSM's first 17 games. Case dished out a season-high five assists against Mesa State on January 4th.

Run & gun: Through 17 games, **Grant Gunhus** is averaging 6.8 points per game. Gunhus tied a career-high with two blocked shots against Mesa State on January 4th. Gunhus, who earned Academic All-RMAC recognition as a sophomore, averaged 7.0 ppg and 1.9 rpg while competing in all 27 contests in 2006-07.

Fresh start: Freshman **Niko Marinucci** has started six of the Orediggers' last seven games. Marinucci established career highs in points (13) and assists (five) on January 4th against Mesa State.

Drew's news: **Drew Hoffman** registered a career-best 17 points against Mesa State on Jan. 4th. Hoffman is currently ranked second on the team with 11 steals.

Hamilton headlines: **Levi Hamilton** established a career-high with nine rebounds against Mesa State on Jan. 4th.

Following Frieauf: **Chad Frieauf** is averaging 10.1 ppg and a team-second-best 5.1 rpg in eight games played this season (six starts). The most prolific quarterback in the history of Mines football, Frieauf won the Harlon Hill Trophy as the top player in all of NCAA Division II college football following his senior season in 2004. Frieauf lettered as a redshirt freshman on the CSM basketball squad in 2002-03.
