## HEAD COACH PRYOR ORSER

The 2007-08 season will mark Pryor Orser's seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at CSM.

Last winter, CSM compiled a 14-13 overall record and posted an 8-11 mark in the RMAC. Three Orediggers earned recognition on the All-RMAC teams, including Ian Elseth (Second Team All-East Division), Kyle Pape (Second Team All-East Division) and Franklin Ryk (Honorable Mention All-East Division).

Orser's previous coaching experience includes a four-year stint at Northwest College (Wyoming), where he served as the head coach of the women's program and also as an assistant with the men's team. Also a physical education instructor at Northwest, Orser's women compiled a program-record 22 victories during his fourth and final season, marking a 20-game improvement from his first year at the helm.

In addition to spending two seasons as the assistant men's basketball coach and the assistant S.I.D. at Carroll College in Helena, Montana, Orser served for three years as the assistant coach for the Montana State University - Billings men's basketball team.

A graduate of Gardiner High School in Gardiner, Montana, Orser was selected as the Class C State MVP as a senior in 1985. Orser lettered all four years at MSU - Billings, leading the Yellowjackets to a pair of NCAA Division II tournament appearances and a trip to the 1986-87 NCAA Division II Final Four. MSU - Billings won more than 80 games during Orser's collegiate career. Following his senior season, Orser garnered Honorable Mention All-Conference accolades.

In the spring of 2005, *Westword Newspaper* named Orser's Basketball Camps as the Best Place for Young Hoops Hotshots in its annual Best of Denver issue. Orser's camps have grown each year and have attracted as many as 140 players during a single week.

Orser received his bachelor's degree in Business Administration - Finance with minors in Economics and History from Eastern Montana College in 1990 before earning his master's in Education from Montana State University - Billings (1995).

## OREDIGGER GAME NOTES

**Next week:** Following this week's games at Chadron State (Thursday, Jan. 24th) and Nebraska - Kearney (Saturday, Jan. 26th), CSM will play at Regis University (Friday, Feb. 1st) and at UC - Colorado Springs (Saturday, Feb. 2nd).

**Roadrunners edge Orediggers, 64-62:** Metro State defeated Mines by the score of 64-62 in RMAC action last Saturday, January 19th, at Lockridge Arena. **Ben Mohr** (8-of-10 FG) amassed a 17-point, 11-rebound double-double for the Orediggers, who out-rebounded MSCD 29 to 22. **Kyle Pape** recorded 11 points, five assists and five rebounds as Mines, which shot 65.2 % from the floor in the second half, dropped to 9-10 overall (2-7 RMAC).

**Colorado Christian defeats Mines, 82-76:** Colorado Christian University defeated CSM by the score of 82-76 in RMAC action last Friday, January 18th, at Lockridge Arena. **Kyle Pape** (12-of-12 FT), who went 5-of-9 from three-point range, led all scorers with 31 points. **Ben Mohr** (game-high eight rebounds, four assists) went 11-of-14 from the field and concluded the night with 24 points as Mines dropped to 9-9 overall (2-6 RMAC).

**Flivin' Hawaiian:** **Kyle Pape** is currently ranked second in the RMAC in scoring with 18.9 ppg. Pape, who registered a season-high 31 points on Jan. 18th vs. CCU, has reached the 20-point plateau in 12 of 19 games. Even more, Pape is currently ranked third in the RMAC in free throw % (.851; 86-of-101). Pape has reached double figures in scoring in all but two games this year. Selected to the 2007-08 Pre-Season All-RMAC East Division Team, Pape was the only Oredigger to start all 27 games during his sophomore campaign in 2006-07. Pape, who earned Second Team All-RMAC East Division accolades last winter, garnered RMAC Freshman of the Year and RMAC Shootout All-Tournament honors during his first season at Colorado School of Mines in 2005-06.

**Big Ben:** Through 19 games, **Ben Mohr** is currently ranked second in the RMAC in rebounding (9.6 rpg). Mohr, who notched a career-best 24 points on Jan. 18th against Colorado Christian University, is averaging a team-second-best 14.7 points per game. Mohr has six double-doubles in 2007-08 and has reached double figures in rebounds on nine occasions. Mohr has also reached double figures in scoring in 14 of 19 games. Mohr is also ranked second in the RMAC in FG % (.639; 108-of-169), sixth in assists (4.05 apg) and seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.64). Mohr currently leads CSM in blocked shots (10) and steals (17). Selected as the RMAC Freshman of the Year in 2004-05, Mohr earned Academic All-RMAC honors last year.

**Providing assistance:** After compiling 62 assists and 24 steals in 2006-07, **Casey O'Hayre** is averaging a team-second-best 2.3 assists per game this winter. O'Hayre, who is currently ranked second on the team in steals (13), has dished out five assists four times this winter. O'Hayre, who played in all 27 games last year, was an Academic All-RMAC performer in the classroom as a sophomore.

**Case file:** **Jacob Case** is averaging 6.5 ppg and 2.5 rpg through CSM's first 19 games. Case dished out a season-high five assists against Mesa State on January 4th.

**Run & gun:** Through 19 games, **Grant Gunhus** is averaging 6.4 points per game. Gunhus tied a career-high with two blocked shots against Mesa State on January 4th. Gunhus, who earned Academic All-RMAC recognition as a sophomore, averaged 7.0 ppg and 1.9 rpg while competing in all 27 contests in 2006-07.

**Drew's news:** **Drew Hoffman** registered a career-best 17 points against Mesa State on Jan. 4th. Hoffman is currently ranked third on the team with 11 steals.

**Hamilton headlines:** **Levi Hamilton** established a career-high with nine rebounds against Mesa State on Jan. 4th.

**Following Frieauf:** **Chad Frieauf** is averaging 9.3 ppg and a team-second-best 4.8 rpg in 10 games played this season (eight starts). The most prolific quarterback in the history of Mines football, Frieauf won the Harlon Hill Trophy as the top player in all of NCAA Division II college football following his senior season in 2004. Frieauf lettered as a redshirt freshman on the CSM basketball squad in 2002-03.
