## HEAD COACH PRYOR ORSER

The 2007-08 season will mark Pryor Orser's seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at CSM.

Last winter, CSM compiled a 14-13 overall record and posted an 8-11 mark in the RMAC. Three Orediggers earned recognition on the All-RMAC teams, including Ian Elseth (Second Team All-East Division), Kyle Pape (Second Team All-East Division) and Franklin Ryk (Honorable Mention All-East Division).



**PRYOR ORSER**  
**7th season at CSM**  
**88-102 (52-77 RMAC)**

Orser's previous coaching experience includes a four-year stint at Northwest College (Wyoming), where he served as the head coach of the women's program and also as an assistant with the men's team. Also a physical education instructor at Northwest, Orser's women compiled a program-record 22 victories during his fourth and final season, marking a 20-game improvement from his first year at the helm.

In addition to spending two seasons as the assistant men's basketball coach and the assistant S.I.D. at Carroll College in Helena, Montana, Orser served for three years as the assistant coach for the Montana State University - Billings men's basketball team.

A graduate of Gardiner High School in Gardiner, Montana, Orser was selected as the Class C State MVP as a senior in 1985. Orser lettered all four years at MSU - Billings, leading the Yellowjackets to a pair of NCAA Division II tournament appearances and a trip to the 1986-87 NCAA Division II Final Four. MSU - Billings won more than 80 games during Orser's collegiate career. Following his senior season, Orser garnered Honorable Mention All-Conference accolades.

In the spring of 2005, *Westword Newspaper* named Orser's Basketball Camps as the Best Place for Young Hoops Hotshots in its annual Best of Denver issue. Orser's camps have grown each year and have attracted as many as 140 players during a single week.

Orser received his bachelor's degree in Business Administration - Finance with minors in Economics and History from Eastern Montana College in 1990 before earning his master's in Education from Montana State University - Billings (1995).

## OREDIGGER GAME NOTES

**Next week:** Following this week's 8:00 p.m. home games vs. UCCS (Fri., Feb. 15th) and Regis University (Sat., Feb. 16th), CSM will conclude the regular-season portion of its 2007-08 schedule by playing at Metro State (Fri., Feb. 22nd at 7:00 p.m.) and CCU (Sat., Feb. 23rd at 7:00 p.m.).

**Orediggers clip Eagles, 60-57:** CSM defeated Chadron State by the score of 60-57 last Saturday, February 9th, at Lockridge Arena. **Kyle Pape** (6-of-9 FG, 5-of-6 FT) led all players in points (20), rebounds (eight) and steals (five) as the Orediggers won their fourth straight game. **Chad Frieauf** chipped in with seven rebounds while **Levi Hamilton** and **Casey O'Hayre** accounted for eight points apiece.

**Mines outlasts UNK, 86-79:** Mines defeated Nebraska - Kearney by the score of 86-79 last Friday, February 8th, at Lockridge Arena. **Kyle Pape** (11-of-11 FT, five rebounds) and **Ben Mohr** recorded 26 and 25 points, respectively, as the Orediggers came away victorious. Mohr, who went 12-of-13 from the field, scored 18 points in the second half to help CSM overcome a seven-point halftime deficit. Mohr and **Casey O'Hayre** grabbed six boards apiece as the Orediggers outscored the Lopers 52-38 in the second stanza.

**Flyin' Hawaiian:** **Kyle Pape** is currently ranked second in the RMAC in scoring with 20.6 ppg. Pape, who registered a career-high 37 points at UNK on Jan. 26th, has reached the 20-point plateau in 16 of 23 games. On Feb. 9th against Chadron State, Pape established career highs in rebounds (eight) and steals (five). Currently ranked third in the RMAC in free throw % (.884; 130-of-147), Pape has reached double figures in scoring in all but two games this year. Selected to the 2007-08 Pre-Season All-RMAC East Division Team, Pape was the only Oredigger to start all 27 games during his sophomore campaign in 2006-07. Pape, who earned Second Team All-RMAC East Division accolades last winter, garnered RMAC Freshman of the Year and RMAC Shootout All-Tournament honors during his first season at CSM.

**Big Ben:** Through 25 games, **Ben Mohr** is currently ranked first in the RMAC in total rebounds (216) and second in rebounds per game (9.00 rpg). Mohr, who has reached double figures in rebounds on 10 occasions this season, is also the owner of a team-second-best 14.0 ppg (15th in the RMAC). Mohr notched a career-best 25 points against UNK on Jan. 18th at Lockridge Arena. Mohr has also reached double figures in scoring in 17 of his 24 games played. Mohr is also currently ranked second in the RMAC in FG % (.644; 132-of-205), fourth in assists (4.17 apg) and fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.72). Mohr currently leads CSM in blocked shots (12) and steals (20). Selected as the RMAC Freshman of the Year in 2004-05, Mohr is a three-time Academic All-RMAC performer in the classroom (sophomore, junior, senior).

**5 and dime:** **Casey O'Hayre** is averaging a team-second-best 2.1 assists per game this season. O'Hayre, who is currently ranked second on the team in steals (17), has dished out five assists on two occasions in 2007-08. Furthermore, O'Hayre has distributed four "dimes" in four other games this winter. O'Hayre, who registered a season-best 12 points at Chadron State on Jan. 24th, collected a career-best six rebounds vs. UNK on Feb. 8th. O'Hayre, who played in all 27 games last year, is a two-time Academic All-RMAC performer (sophomore, junior).

**Hamilton headlines:** **Levi Hamilton** has earned Academic All-RMAC recognition (Honor Roll) for 2007-08. Hamilton tied a career high with nine rebounds in CSM's 79-72 victory at UCCS on Feb. 2nd.

**Stealing the spotlight:** **Sean Armstrong** had a career-best four steals in CSM's 79-72 victory at UCCS on Feb. 2nd.

**Frieauf flourishing in February:** **Chad Frieauf** is currently ranked second in the team in rebounding (4.9 rpg) and third in scoring (9.3 ppg). The most prolific quarterback in the history of Mines football, Frieauf won the Harlon Hill Trophy as the top player in all of NCAA Division II college football following his senior season in 2004. After redshirting on the CSM basketball squad during the 2001-02 campaign, Frieauf lettered as a redshirt freshman in 2002-03.
