

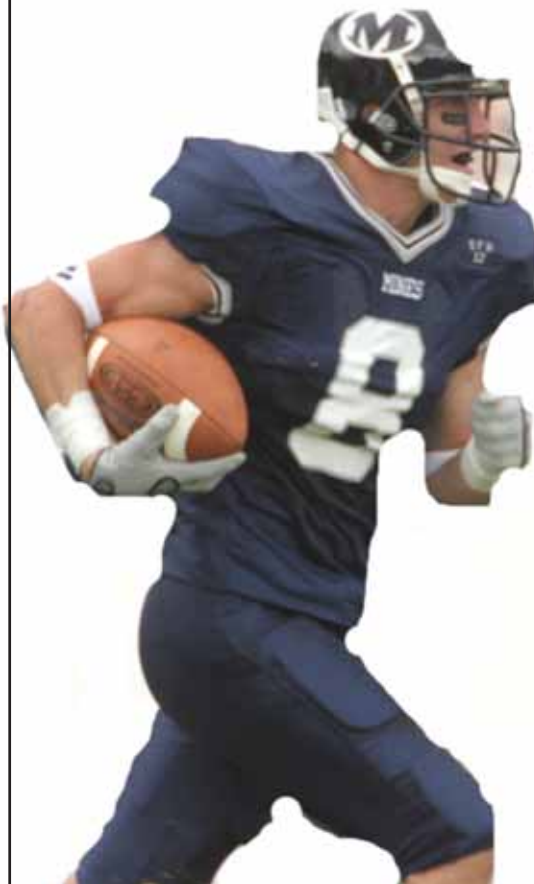

This JUST-IN

- First Team All-RMAC wide receiver and kick returner. RMAC Wide Receiver and Special Teams Player of the Year.
- Street and Smith First Team Preseason All-American in 2005. Also a Preseason Second Team pick by Lindy's and a Preseason All-American choice by *Don Hansen's Football Gazette*.
- Gallas leads all of NCAA Division II in all-purpose yards (238.5 ypg) and receptions per game (8.3 rpg), is fourth in kickoff returns (30.6 ypr) and sixth in receiving yards per game (109.0 ypg).
- Leads all of Division II in all-purpose yards (2,624), kickoff return yards (1,256) and receptions (91).
- His 2,624 all-purpose yards are 6th best in a single season in DII.
- Has recorded at least 100 receiving yards in nine of 11 games, at least 10 catches in five games and nine catches once this season.
- Has topped 200 all-purpose yards six times this season, including a season best 366 in a 42-41 win over Fort Lewis (10/15) which included a 100 yard kickoff return for a touchdown.
- RMAC Special Teams Player of the Week in win over Fort Lewis.
- Leads team with 91 catches, 1,199 receiving yards and eight scores. His 91 catches are second most in a CSM single season.
- Holds CSM career records for receptions (266) and receiving yards (3,562). His 266 career receptions rank 9th all-time in Division II and second all-time in the RMAC and his receiving yardage total is 4th all-time in the RMAC.
- Has topped 100 receiving yards 17 times in his career.
- In 2004, Gallas hauled in a school-record 95 catches which tied him for the 18th best season in Division II history. He also recorded a school-record 1,352 receiving yards and 10 touchdowns.
- Posted 15 catches for 243 yards and two touchdowns in two playoff games in 2004.
- First Team All-RMAC as wide receiver and Second Team All-RMAC as a punt returner in 2004. Also earned First Team All-Southwest Region and Second Team All-American accolades.
- Second Team All-RMAC as a sophomore when he tallied 44 catches for 602 yards and four touchdowns. Hauled in 36 passes for 408 yards and a score as a freshman.
