Minor / Area of Special Interest

1. A minor program of study must consist of a minimum of 18 credit hours or a logical sequence of courses, only 3 hours of which may be at 100 or 200 level. No more than 3 credit hours of the sequence may be taken in the student’s degree-granting department.
2. ASI Information: An Area of Special Interest (ASI) must consist of a minimum of 12 credit hours of a logical sequence of courses, only 3 hours of which may be at the 100 or 200 level. No courses may be used that are required by the degree program in which the student is majoring.
3. Math & Chemistry ASI Exception: Math and Chemistry major students may not use courses for their ASI that are required by their degree.
4. Students in the McBride program are required to maintain an overall GPA of 2.9. Students are required to maintain a GPA of 3.0 in all McBride classes. See the *Standards of Student Performance* for more information.
