Previously, Mr. DeFilippo served in the United States Navy and was a policeman on the New York City Police Department. After graduation, Mr. DeFilippo worked in the coal mining industry and had a small consulting company in Golden and became a professional engineer in Colorado. In 1978, he was elected to the Colorado House of Representatives from the Golden – Evergreen area where he served for six years. During that period, he was chairman of the State Affairs Committee, vice-chairman of the Transportation and Energy Committee and a member of the Finance Committee. He also served as Speaker of the House pro-tempore under House Speaker Bev Bledsoe. Mr. DeFilippo was also a member to the transition teams of both President Reagan and Governor Bill Owens.

Mr. DeFilippo was appointed to the Colorado School of Mines Board of Trustees in March 2005.
