

*Meeting Minutes of the Association of Classified Employees (ACE)  
Council*

*November 30, 2006*

*The meeting was called to order at 2:05 p.m.*

*Mission Statement was read.*

- 4) Spring Social—ACE will conduct an early poll to decide whether or not we want to do the same thing or try an alternative such as a paid band, a block of tickets to some show or event. We will work on this after the first of the year.*
- 5) Other—Erin to continue to be the moderator of our website.*
- 6) Other other—Amendment 41 passed concerning gift money and this will affect the ACE-in-the-Hole donations/giving. Anything >*

- \$50 is a problem under the current law. ACE will have to decide if there is another way to use the funds for a positive service to our community such as professional development classes or something along those lines.*
- 7) Other other other—Debbie has been approached at a couple of meetings regarding our role in dispersing information regarding Banner. We are uncertain what our role should be. If the administration feels it is our role to provide this type of communication to our constituency, then we should be included in their Banner and reorg. task force and meetings as necessary so that we can communicate pertinent information. Originally, ACE's role was simply to communicate upward from our constituents to administration—more so than down from them to constituents. BOT limited our function in order for ACE to be adopted as a council.*
