Non-U.S. Institutions	Mines students attending colleges outside the U.S. are assessed tuition as determined by the Office of International Programs. Charges may be guided by agreements with cooperating institutions.
COOP	Mines students on COOP are not charged tuition and fees.
WICHE Graduate Students	Graduate students accepted under agreement with WICHE are assessed resident tuition.
High School Concurrent Enrollment	Concurrently enrolled high school students from the Jefferson County School district will be assessed a tuition rate equivalent to the Resident Community College rate. Students will need to authorize the use of COF for Mines.
CHGN198A and CHGN198B	Active duty military students enrolled in CHGN198A and CHGN198B will be assessed a tuition rate of \$250 per student credit hour.

REFUND POLICY**

The amount of tuition and fee assessments is based primarily on each student's enrolled courses. In the event a student withdraws from a course or courses, assessments will be adjusted as follows:

If withdrawal from a course or courses is made prior to the end of the add/drop period for the term of enrollment, as determined by the Registrar, tuition and fees will be adjusted to the new course level without penalty.

If withdrawal from a course or courses is made after the add/drop period, regardless of whether or not the student officially withdraws from Mines, no adjustments in charges will be made.

Please note: students receiving federal financial aid under the Title IV programs may have a different refund as required by federal law or regulations.
