FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - FALL 2022

The Colorado School of Mines is committed to continuing to offer both in-person and virtual recruiting options. We feel that offering both methods will best serve our students and employer partners, as we saw with our Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 events.

Similar to last year, we will be hosting the Virtual Career Day on the Career Fair Plus platform. You will have the opportunity to create group or 1:1 schedules for students to sign up and meet with your recruiters. We will send additional information and invitations to training sessions as we get closer to the event date. Thank you for your understanding and thank you for partnering with the Colorado School of Mines.

May 19th: Registration

- · Register on DiggerNet: https://mines-csm.symplicity.com/employers/
- Make sure your company information, logo, website links, etc. are all correct with what you want displayed on the platform.
- The person who registers the company will also be the one to receive the invitation later on to start building schedules. Make sure you add any additional recruiters who should receive this email.

August 1st: The event is launched on Career Fair Plus

- The person who registered for the event will receive an email inviting them to start building schedules and add other recruiters on the Career Fair Plus platform.
- You can build as many schedules as you want, there are both group and 1:1 options. We will send invitations to trainings on how to use CFP at a later date; you can also check out our Career Fair Plus Resources webpage for more information at https://www.mines.edu/careers/cfpresources/
- Any employer added to the platform can build schedules for themselves or the team. You will be able to build schedules up until the event.

September 5th: Booking Window Opens

- •The booking window will open at 7am, allowing students to start booking meetings with employers
- Make sure you have all your schedules finalized by this date. We cannot move a student's booking. If you need to change or
 delete a schedule after a student has already signed up, their reservation will be deleted and they will need to select a new
 time. Reach out to Adriana at aalba@mines.edu if you need any support.
- You will still be able to create schedules up until the event, however the sooner they are created, the more students will have a chance to select a meeting time.

September 21: Virtual

- Check to make sure your video and audio are working in advance, and that you are able to access the schedules on Career Fair Plus.
- Virtual Career Day runs from 9 a.m. 3 p.m. MST.
- Students will be able to book meetings until 2:30 p.m. on this day, so that anyone can still meet with you if they sign up on the day-of.

FEES & PACKAGE DETAILS

Basic Career Day Package Includes:

- A virtual booth on the Career Fair Plus platform, where your company information and logo will be displayed along with any additional information provided in your registration.
- Chat with students over text, audio, or video.
- Easy access to students' documents, including their resume, and the ability to set follow-up actions with each candidate or forward candidates to your colleagues.
- Company name included in the "Majors Matrix" which is strongly advertised to students.
- · Company listing in DiggerNet.
- The opportunity to participate in other Career Day events (for example WIRED! - Prep with Reps, SWE, Next Day Interviews, etc.)

^{*}Companies already registered for the in-person Career Day may register for the Virtual Career Day at a reduced rate of \$200. You MUST still register separately for the In-Person Career Day. If you paid for a Featured Sponsored spot at the In-Person Career Day, you will be a featured sponsor for virtual as well.

MAKING A PAYMENT

- Payment is due within 30 days after registration or two weeks prior to the event (whichever comes first), unless written arrangements have been made with the Career Center. You may pay by check or credit card, though credit card is the preferred method.
- If paying by check, print invoice attached to the confirmation email and forward with a check to:

- You will receive an email when Mines receives your payment.
- Registrations without payment 2 weeks before Career Day will be considered incomplete and may be cancelled. An administrative fee may be assessed. For questions on invoices, contact L. Jane Cain at (303) 273-3233 or lcain@mines.edu. See cancellation policy below.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Cancellations must be in writing. Companies are considered registered upon form completion (whether paid or not).
- Full refunds will be given if canceled by/before August 24, 2022.
- 50% refunds will be given if canceled after August 24, 2022.
- If the cancellation is less than 10 days prior to the event, the full registration fee is non-refundable.
- If the company is confirmed, but has not paid, they would be billed for the aforementioned charges incurred.

WIRED! - PREP WITH REPS EVENT

WIRED! - Prep with Reps is an opportunity for company representatives to meet students and assist with their professional development by offering individual resume reviews, interview tips, and professional development advice before Career Day. Please note that the format of WIRED! Prep with Reps will be updated this year to give employers enhanced opportunities to meet with and support students. Employers will have the opportunity to represent various topics areas such as Resumes, Booth Approach, and Interviewing to assist students in skill building. There will be a \$100 flat fee for employers to attend this event. This is a separate registration process from Career Day. Please log into your DiggerNet account at https://mines-csm.symplicity.com/employers/ and get signed up.

This will be an in-person event for Fall 2022, we will not be holding a virtual WIRED event. The event will take place on Monday, September 12th from Noon - 3 pm MST.

SCHEDULING INTERVIEWS OR INFO SESSIONS

Next Day Interviews -

Interview reservations are free per booth with Career Day registration. This is a separate registration process from Career Day (if you have indicated your interest in your Career Day registration – you will be contacted to complete the registration process).

Information Sessions -

Career Day participants have the option to schedule information sessions during Career Day week, or later in the semester. This is a separate registration process from Career Day (although you may have indicated your interest in your Career Day registration). Cost: \$100

CAREER FAIR PLUS - VIRTUAL BOOTH

Information provided in the registration process (majors recruited, levels, position types, contact information) is published and made visible on the Career Fair Plus platform. While updates are possible after your initial registration, once data is pulled for publication creation, this is what students will see in the app and online. Once the event is Live in the Career Fair Plus app, within 24 hours of your registration being approved you will be able to see your booth and any information you provided. You can do so by downloading and accessing the app through your phone. Should you wish to make any changes to the information shown, such as your company overview, website links, majors recruited, logo, etc., or if you have any questions about viewing this information, please email Adriana Alba at alba@mines.edu.

When the event goes live, you will also receive an email inviting you to start building your schedules. Students will be able to start booking times the week before the Virtual Career Day. You will be sent more information on how to set up these schedules, what to expect, and more.
