- Support the launch of new mission-driven entrepreneurship university programs.
- Maintain professional and effective relationships with university teaching teams, partners, and clients to maintain the highest quality of the program.
- Executing data collection across the national security entrepreneurship programs.
- Prepare surveys and assessment tools to evaluate the performance of the program against the program sponsor objectives.
- Observe and analyze university needs and demand signals to iterate on and improve the national security entrepreneurship programs.
- Enhance the curriculum, content, tools, and community for existing and new universities under the supervision of the National Security Programs Manager and the Director of Programs.
- Execute Educator Courses for our university programs.
- Support event logistics and reporting.
- Assist with the development of program marketing collateral.
- Assist with maintaining website content for CMP national security education programs.
