Challenge Exams are by invitation only and students who qualify will be sent an invitation through their Mines email account by the respective academic department offering the exam opportunity.

#### **Eligibility and Information**

- Generally determined by achieving a specific score on an AP or IB exam
- Students must be in their first two semesters at Mines
- Not every foundational course may have a challenge exam
- Exams cannot be given to receive credit for upperdivision courses
- Challenge exams are offered and managed fully by academic departments

# The following will disqualify a student from taking a challenge exam:

- Denying AP or IB credit and then attempting to take a challenge exam to receive credit
- Attempting to take a challenge exam to receive credit

for a course for which credit has already been awarded

 Continuing students who are in their third or later semester
