### **On-Campus Job: Undergraduate Writing Fellows**

The Writing Center is hiring multiple Undergraduate Writing Fellows. The Application is due midnight on Tuesday, October 18th. The job description is below, but there is more information in the application itself.

The Writing Center seeks undergraduate student applications for Undergraduate Writing Fellows (UWF) for the Fall 2022 Semester. New hires are eligible to continue tutoring during the Spring 2023 Semester. The Undergraduate Writing Fellows will serve as a peer tutor for the Writing Center after undergoing training in Writing Center Theory and Practice, and will receive \$15/hour. Tutoring hours will be flexible based on your schedule, but should generally occur between 6:00-9:00 pm Sundays through Thursdays for approximately 5-6 hours/week. To be eligible, applicants should have already completed HASS 100 or its equivalent and carry a GPA of 3.6 or higher. Applications are due by Tuesday, October 18th, at midnight.
