Previous Minutes. By motion, duly seconded, and unanimously passed, the minutes for the July 10, 1959 meeting were approved without change.

Patent Policy. President Vanderwilt reported that the administration was not yet ready to make a recommendation for a school policy on employees' patents. He stated that the only case which needed immediate action was a graduate student, Andreas G. Papayannopoulos, whose work on his Master's degree in the Petroleum Refining Department had resulted in a possible patentable process.

Dean Jordan had recommended by letter to Mr. Papayannopoulos that he submit his invention through the CSM Foundation, Inc. to the Research Corporation, New York, for their consideration. If the Research Corporation decides that it is willing to accept the invention and file a patent application, they will enter into an agreement with the CSM Foundation, Inc. and Mr. Papayannopoulos for patenting and licensing the invention; the Research Corporation, under the agreement, assumes the responsibility of patenting costs, licensing, and promotion, to be repaid from royalties with net income to be divided among the three principals in accordance with a formula to be agreed upon.

The Board approved Dean Jordan's recommendation.

Advisory Group. Action was deferred until there was a full meeting of the Board.

New Building - CSM Research Foundation, Inc. President Vanderwilt presented the plans for the new analytical wing being planned by the Research Foundation. The Board reviewed the plans and approved the plans as presented.

Inter-University Research Association. This proposed organization being considered by the University of Colorado, Colorado State University, and the Colorado School of Mines for the purpose of engaging in research projects to be handled jointly was discussed. President Vanderwilt read the proposed memorandum of agreement. The Board questioned whether this was within the school's intent as established by the statute. President Vanderwilt was instructed to go back to the other institutions and ascertain whether or not this was within the corporate rights of the institutions involved.

Association of Rocky Mountain Universities, Inc. This organization which had been discussed at the May and July meetings of the Board was again brought up. The same question was raised as to whether the school had a right to enter into such an arrangement. It was unanimously agreed that the school should not enter into this agreement at this time.

Mr. Fenwick left the meeting at this time.

Mr. Steinhauer entered the meeting.

Expense Accounts. In connection with an expense account which was not fully itemized, the question was raised whether the school should require itemized statements even though state policy authorized payment of \$15.00 per day without requiring a detailed listing of costs. It was pointed out that unless itemized, cost comparisons would not be possible. It was suggested by the Board that the administration, after a study, present a recommendation for its consideration at a later meeting.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer presented the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation and Disbursements as of July 31, 1959; Balance Sheet, July 31, 1959; Mill Levy Building Fund as of July 31, 1959; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation and Disbursements as of July 20, 1959; Dining Hall covering period July 6, 1959 through June 30, 1960; Statement of Income & Expense, Mines Park, as of July 20, 1959; Mines Park, Summary of Budget Receipts & Disbursements as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, Prospector Park, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, Mines Bradford Hall & New Dormitory, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, CSM Houses - Group #1, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, CSM Houses - Group 2, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, Mines Park Houses, - 29-36 inclusive, as of July 20, 1959; Summary of Budget Receipts and Disbursements, Mines Park Houses, 29-36 inclusive, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, CSM Houses Group #1 & Mines Park Houses, 29-36 inclusive, as of July 20, 1959; Statement of Income & Expense, 1958-59 Health & Accident Plan, Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, Inc., July 30, 1959; Budget Period, 1958-59 Health and Accident Plan, Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, Inc., July 31, 1959; Athletic Association, Summary of Budget Appropriations and Disbursements as of July 20, 1959.

Budget, Student Health and Accident Plan, 1959-60. Mr. Steinhauer presented the proposed budget for the 1959-60 Student Health and Accident Plan. Based on estimated student enrollment figures, the budget showed a deficit of \$363.00. Mr. Steinhauer recommended that rather than increase Student Health Fees, the budget be approved as presented. The Board approved the budget.

Budget, 1960-61. Mr. Steinbauer reviewed the estimated budget for 1960-61, which was to be presented for review by the state Budget Office and the Joint Budget Committee. Faculty increases were mentioned and it was agreed that the figures presented should reflect an increase sufficient to raise the average faculty salary to \$7,500 per year, providing this approach was to be used by the other state institutions.

Mr. Steinbauer was directed to prepare a comparative budget statement showing receipts and disbursements for the period 1956-57 to the present time.

No action was taken on the proposed budget.

The Board adjourned for lunch in the school dining hall and discussions continued.

Rezoning. President Vanderwilt reviewed the status of the proposed rezoning on 19th Street from Illinois Street to a point 1100 ft. west. The City Council has passed the proposed rezoning on first reading, 6 to 3, on August 13. The public hearing on the rezoning was to be held on September 10, 1959.

Residency for Tuition Purposes. President Vanderwilt and Mr. Steinbauer reviewed changes in residency status for voting purposes made by the last legislature. They also discussed recent opinions of the Attorney General on residency for tuition purposes. The Attorney General had stated that a student became a resident as soon as he moved to Colorado and indicated the adoption of Colorado as a fixed and permanent home. Concern was expressed that such a ruling made determination of residency difficult and also there would be a large decrease in student receipts. President Vanderwilt stated that a meeting of the Presidents' Association was to be held on August 25 at which time the situation would be discussed. The Board felt a uniform policy for the determination of residency status should be adopted by all state-supported colleges and universities.

The Board reconvened in the President's Office.

Location of Science Building. President Vanderwilt reviewed the use and proposed locations of the new science building. He stated that the administration felt the building should be used to house the physics department and possibly other departments such as the electrical engineering department.

The architects had presented recommendations on three alternate sites for the building. Their first preference was the location on 16th Street in the block bordered by Cheyenne and Arapahoe Streets. After a brief discussion, the Board approved the site as recommended. It was agreed that in the event land acquisition presented undue difficulty, the location should be reconsidered.

Allowable Deductions - Annuity Program.

Mr. Steinbauer reviewed the conditions of the Internal Revenue Technical Amendments Act of 1958 which gives employees of educational and other non-profit institutions the option of having part of their salaries paid to them in the form of a contribution that would be made by the employer to some type of annuity plan, the advantage being the employee would pay income tax on the amount of salary actually paid to them, not on the amount paid to the annuity plan. The amount paid to the annuity plan can be up to 20% of the salary involved. Mr. Steinbauer stated that he had sent a copy of the plan as presented by TIAA, an annuity plan organization, to the Attorney General to see if the school, on the Board's authority, could make this available to employees. The Board approved the investigation of this plan.

Clay Pit Area. Mr. Steinbauer reported that it had not been possible to arrange a meeting of those concerned but he hoped such a meeting could be arranged in the near future.

Property.

Aller Property, 1218 Sixteenth Street.

Mr. Steinbauer reported that a tenant was in the house, purchase of which was reported at the May meeting of the Board.

Coolbaugh Residence, 1700 Maple Street.

Mr. Steinbauer stated that the Coolbaughs had inquired if the school would be interested in purchasing the house. An appraisal had been made and the property was appraised at \$39,650. Mr. Steinbauer had later been advised by Mrs. Coolbaugh that a decision had been made not to sell at this time.

Fitterer Residence, 1620 Maple Street.

Mr. Steinbauer stated a guardian and trustee was being appointed for Mrs. Fitterer and that he had been contacted by Mrs. Fitterer's nephew regarding purchase of the house. The appraised value of the property was \$15,800. Mr. Steinbauer recommended that we attempt to buy the house at the appraised value. The recommendation was approved.

Willoughby Arms Apartments, 1321 Illinois.

Mr. Steinhauer reported that the purchase of the Willoughby Arms which had been discussed at the March meeting of the Board had also been discussed at the last CSM Foundation meeting. This proposed purchase of the Willoughby Arms was to be brought up at the August 28 meeting of the CSM Foundation. The unfavorable reaction such a purchase would create was again discussed. No action was taken. ✓
