Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on February 8, 1963 were approved as corrected.

Commencement Speaker. President Vanderwilt reported that Mr. R. R. McNaughton, past president once removed of the American Institute of Mining, Metallurgical, and Petroleum Engineers, and Manager of the Metallurgical Division of the Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada Limited, had accepted the invitation to be the Commencement speaker.

Mineral Economics. President Vanderwilt distributed copies of material prepared by Dr. Oscar H. Lentz on the subject of mineral economics, including a suggested curriculum.

Objectives of the School. There was a general discussion on the lack of understanding among legislators and throughout the State in general of the role of the Colorado School of Mines and specific ways of combating this lack of knowledge. It was generally agreed that the School should take decisive action to preserve the role which it has traditionally held.

Association of Governing Boards. President Vanderwilt reported that a statement had been received for annual dues for membership in the Association of Governing Boards. The motion to continue membership died for lack of a second.

Faculty Tuition. President Vanderwilt distributed copies of a memorandum from Dean Jordan on the reciprocal arrangements being considered with regard to faculty from state schools paying tuition.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer entered the meeting and reviewed the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 28, 1963; Balance Sheet, February 28, 1963; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of February 28, 1963; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 19, 1963; College Union Fund, Summary of Budget Appropriation and Disbursements, as of February 27, 1963; Statement of Income & Expense, C.S.M. Dormitory System Revenue Fund, as of February 19, 1963; Statement of Income & Expense, C.S.M. Self-Maintained Properties, as of February 19, 1963; Budget Period, 1962-63 Health and Accident Plan, Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, Inc., as of February 28, 1963; and the Athletic Association, Summary of Budget Appropriations and Disbursements, as of February 20, 1963.

Tax-Sheltered Annuity. Mr. Steinhauer reported that the faculty, at the February meeting, accepted the recommendation that the Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association program

be made available.

Upon motion by Mr. Johnston, seconded by Mr. Coors, it was unanimously passed that Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association program be offered to the employees of the School as a choice over Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company

HNFA Project. Mr. Steinbauer reported that the bids for Project 1031, site preparation and installation of utilities for the married student housing area of the west campus, had been opened on March 5, 1963 in the office of the State Purchasing Agent.

Upon motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the Board authorized acceptance of the low bid of \$82,662.80 by Emerson Ellett, Inc.

Mr. Steinbauer reported that the Acting Director of the State Planning Division had expressed a desire to have from the Board some record of the availability of the additional funds which would be needed in the event the entire HNFA project costs as much as Mr. Sudler last estimated. The Board agreed it would be proper to send such a letter.

Fitterer Property - 1820 Maple. Mr. Steinbauer reported that the guardian of the estate had agreed to sell the property to the school and was awaiting the required approval of the District Court to complete the purchase and sale agreement.

Jefferson Clay and Investment Company Property - 19th and Elm. Mr. Steinbauer reported that it was necessary to institute quiet title suit to clear title to the triangular piece of property at 19th and Elm which the School had acquired in lieu of royalty payment on clay mined under agreement made when west campus was acquired. The suit had been instituted and costs were being borne by the Jefferson Clay and Investment Company.

Sale of Basketball Floor. Mr. Steinbauer reported that he had been negotiating with the school board from Kersey, Colorado on the sale of this portable floor. The Board authorized Mr. Steinbauer to negotiate down to \$4,000 on this sale and obtain permission from the State Purchasing Agent for such a sale.

Property at 19th and Illinois. Mr. Steinbauer reported that he had been contacted by Mr. Robert Fleming about the property. The members of the Board suggested that we enter into a purchase and sale agreement at the appraised price to tie up the property.

Names for Buildings. Dr. Parker asked that consideration be given at the April Board meeting to names for buildings as yet unnamed.

Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on March 8, 1963 were approved.

Reappointment to the Board. The other members of the Board expressed their pleasure in and appreciation of the fact that Mr. Coors' term had been extended for another six years.

Honorary Degree. President Vanderwilt recommended to the Board that an honorary degree be awarded to Mr. Ronald H. McNaughton who will make the Commencement speech. The Board reviewed Mr. McNaughton's record and agreed he qualified according to criteria set and approved the recommendation that Mr. McNaughton be awarded an honorary degree of Doctor of Engineering at Commencement on June 7.

Colorado School of Mines Public Image. President Vanderwilt reported on the conclusions made by a committee for the Engineering Manpower Commission on student attrition, pointing out that student recruitment, attrition, and enrollment relate to a school's public image. He recommended that consideration be given to consulting with an outside specialist concerning the image of Mines and how improvement might be made. No action was taken, but it was agreed that the problem warranted further study.

A memorandum from James Sankovitz, public information officer, on reports he had received on the possible future of higher education in Colorado was discussed and concern was expressed on the role the School would play.

Members of the Board were of the opinion that a meeting with the Governor should be sought to bring to the Governor's attention the unique potential of the School in the future of engineering education in Colorado.

Building Designations. President Vanderwilt stated he would have for the next meeting a list of buildings to be named and a list of possible names for these buildings.

Faculty Salaries. President Vanderwilt reviewed the present status of faculty salaries and proposed salary increases. A tentative salary schedule for 1963-64 as prepared by Dean Kuhn was reviewed; and it was pointed out that because salaries in the lower ranks were relatively higher than in the higher ranks, the larger increases were reserved for those in the higher ranks. The increases are within the total dollar amount made available for salary increases.

The members of the Board expressed the strong conviction that the funds available should be used mostly to reward the outstanding men to insure their retention, also that there should be no obligation to give everyone an increase in salary.

April 12, 1963

1963-64 Preliminary Budget. Mr. Steinbauer entered the meeting and reviewed the preliminary budget proposal for 1963-64. After some discussion, the Board on motion made and seconded, approved the budget in the amount of \$2,601,394.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinbauer reviewed the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of March 31, 1963; Balance Sheet, March 31, 1963; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of March 31, 1963; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of March 19, 1963; College Union Fund, Summary of Budget Appropriation and Disbursements, as of March 27, 1963; Statement of Income & Expense, C.S.M. Dormitory System Revenue Fund, as of March 19, 1963; Statement of Income & Expense, C.S.M. Self-Maintained Properties, as of March 19, 1963; Budget Period, 1962-63 Health and Accident Plan, Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, Inc., as of March 29, 1963; and the Athletic Association, Summary of Budget Appropriations and Disbursements, as of March 20, 1963.

BHFA Project. Mr. Steinbauer reported that work had started on Project 1031, site preparation and installation of utilities for the married student housing area of the west campus.

Welch Ditch - West Campus Area. Mr. Steinbauer reported on a request received from the City of Golden for financial assistance toward covering the Welch Ditch where it crosses 18th Street. The question of opening 18th Street from Illinois to Elm was also raised by the City of Golden.

The members of the Board were of the opinion that we should establish a plan of approach to the campus, including the west campus, and let the City know our plans. It was the consensus that the Board should not approve the request being made by the City at this time pending the advice of the architect on the general over-all plans for the campus.

Sigma Phi Epsilon and Sigma Alpha Epsilon Sites. President Vanderwilt reported on letters received from these two fraternities inquiring as to the plans of the School in relation to expansion of the campus to include the sites presently occupied by these fraternities. The members of the Board were in agreement that these two sites are important in our planning and that every effort should be made to purchase the sites.

The Board instructed President Vanderwilt to advise the fraternities that it is in the interest of the School to acquire these two sites; it is our desire to acquire these properties on a proper appraised price value; and that funds appear to be available within approximately two years and perhaps one property could be purchased within one year.

Sigma Nu Fraternity House Plans. A scale model of the new Sigma Nu house was shown to the Board. There was no fundamental objection to the plan by the Board, but the members asked that an opinion be sought from the architect before final approval was given.

Brooks Field Lighting. Mr. Steinhauser reported that an amount of \$30,000 had been appropriated from the Capital Construction Fund for new lighting for Brooks Field. Mr. Greenwald had recommended that a consulting engineer be engaged to design the lighting. The members of the Board suggested that General Electric and Westinghouse also be invited if they offer such a service. The job would be let finally by bids.

Budget - Health and Accident Plan, Associated Students. Mr. Steinhauser distributed copies of the 1963-64 Health and Accident Plan budget in the amount of \$29,309 which involved no increase in Student Health Fees. The Board approved the budget.

Perquisites. President Vanderwilt read a memorandum from the staff director of the Presidents' Association regarding House Bill No. 188 which pertains to perquisites provided certain employees of the state. The State Controller had stated that he had no plans to adopt regulations which would conflict with policies set by boards of institutions.

The members of the Board felt that a list, in some detail, of all perquisites provided should be prepared for the record.

New President. The appointment of Dr. Orlo E. Childs as President of the Colorado School of Mines was discussed. The details involved in the legal change-over were reviewed by Mr. Steinhauser. The date of the change was set tentatively for July 1, 1963.

Signatures. The procedure employed by the administration in the signing of checks was questioned as to legality. Information on this was requested for the May Board meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
