

from the Parfet Estate for \$5,000 which is slightly under the appraised price of similar ground on the other side of the creek and deed it to the School. It was felt that it would be advantageous to obtain this property in the event we might have future need for it and this purchase would consolidate all of our ground on the south side of Clear Creek in that area.

The members of the Board felt that this was not a matter for their decision, but it was up to the Board of the Research Foundation and was referred to them for whatever action they wished to take.

Boettcher and Company Proposal. Mr. Steinhauer stated that he had conferred with Mr. Bruce Newman of Boettcher and Company concerning the proposed legislative bill to permit refunding of our outstanding bond issues and refunding of the fraternity house loans, plus the permissive legislation to lease. This matter had been referred to Mr. Thomas Faxon of the firm of Dawson, Nagel, Sherman, and Howard, who in consultation with Mr. Ted P. Stockmar, was to draw up the necessary legislation. Mr. Newman stated that in his research on the matter it was found that the School had the power to refund under existing statutes but that a bill permitting leasing was necessary. A bill will be prepared and submitted as soon as possible for this purpose.

With regard to the refunding, it was the opinion of the attorneys that the existing revenue bonds should be refunded in one issue and that another issue refunding fraternity house loans would be necessary. The fraternity house loans must be separated from the existing bond issues since it was felt that the fraternity houses were selective in their membership and, therefore, the credit of the School could not be pledged toward the repayment of these bonds. A separate body such as the Colorado School of Mines Foundation, Inc. will have to issue the revenue bonds for the fraternities and some type of secondary security must be guaranteed in order to allow flexibility in the sale of these bonds.

It was the opinion of the members of the Board that no action should be taken on the proposed refunding until permissive legislation to lease has been enacted.

Request from the City of Golden for Conveyance. Mr. Steinhauer read a letter from Mr. Leo Bradley, City Attorney, requesting the School to direct a letter to the State Affairs Committee advising that the School agreed to waive any right to lands lying north of the center line of Clear Creek as described in proposed Senate Bill 48. The Board of Trustees had no objection to the proposed bill except it was felt that the center line of Clear Creek described by a metes and bounds description should be examined to determine if the proposed line is actually in the center of the present creek bed. Mr. Greenwald will be asked to review the metes and bounds description of the proposed center line to determine if it actually lies in the present course of Clear Creek.

Annual Report. Dr. Parker stated that he had studied the annual report of the 1963-64 fiscal year and felt it was outstanding. He expressed concern, however, that it did not

conform with the statutes, particularly in regard to its length. Mr. Steinhauer was requested to ask the Attorney General's office to determine if it conforms to the statutes.

President Childs' Meeting with Governor Love. President Childs reported that he had met with Governor Love regarding our 1965-66 budget request. This meeting was occasioned by a letter written by President Smiley of the University of Colorado to the Joint Budget Committee. President Smiley had stated that the University would be unable to operate under the budget as recommended by the Governor. This letter received wide publicity in the press. Governor Love was appreciative of President Childs' meeting with him and stated he would support an increase in the Governor's recommendations on behalf of the School's request and stated he would have no objection to President Childs conferring with Senator Locke, Chairman of the Joint Budget Committee, about this increase.

Recognition of Norton Brown, Class of 1892. Mr. Fenwick stated he had been approached regarding recognition for Norton Brown of the Class of 1892 as the oldest living graduate of the School. It was the opinion of the Board that this would be recognition for longevity only and that special recognition of this type was more appropriate for the Alumni Association.

The meeting adjourned at 2:30 p.m.

Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on February 12, 1965 were approved.

Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had asked the Attorney General for an opinion as to whether the School has the authority to charge nonresident students resident tuition as would be required if we were to participate in a program sponsored by WICHE.

The reply from the Attorney General was to the effect that the School does not have this authority. President Childs stated he would inquire of other state schools as to the method they use to enable them to participate in these programs.

Honorary Degree. It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that Representative Wayne N. Aspinall be granted an honorary Doctor of Engineering degree at Commencement on June 4, 1965.

Annual Report. President Childs reported that in response to Dr. Parker's inquiry at the February Board meeting, Mr. Steinhauer had written the Attorney General asking whether the Annual Report as published was in conformance with the Colorado statutes. The length of the report does not conflict with the statutes, according to the Attorney General. The question was raised by the Attorney General's staff as to the number of reports published with state funds. In the future, the number to be published will be cleared with the Governor prior to publication.

Press Representation at Board Meetings. President Childs reported on a request from a Denver Post writer for permission to attend Board meetings. The question was deferred because of the absence of two members of the Board.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer distributed copies of the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 28, 1965; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 28, 1965; Balance Sheet, February 28, 1965; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of February 28, 1965; College Union Fund, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 26, 1965; Statement of Income and Expense, C.S.M. Dormitory System Revenue Fund, as of February 20, 1965; Statement of Cash Receipts & Expenditures, C.S.M. Self-Maintained Properties, as of February 20, 1965; Budget Period, 1964-65 Health and Accident Plan, Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, Inc., as of February 22, 1965; Athletic Association, Summary of Budget Appropriation and Disbursements, as of February 28, 1965; and the Office of Research Services, Statement of Cash Receipts and Disbursements, July 1, 1964 to February 28, 1965.

Mr. Fenwick entered the meeting at this time.

ROTC Contract. President Childs reviewed for the Board the status of the ROTC unit which had been on campus since 1918. There had never been a formal contract between the Army and the School. Congress has recently passed new provisions relating to ROTC programs and the School must enter into an agreement to participate. It was noted that the contract submitted by the Department of the Army for signature carried a ninety-day notice of termination period. ✓

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the President be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the School.

Wild Horse Park. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had heard nothing further from Mr. Patrick Bault of California and concluded that there was no possibility of the three-way trade working out. He reported that he had been visited several times by representatives of the Corps of Engineers. He stated that until the Army presents a consolidated offer, there is nothing further to be done at this time. ✓

Rezoning - 19th and Illinois. President Childs reported that a letter had been directed to the City Council protesting on behalf of the School the proposed rezoning at 19th and Illinois. At a meeting held the previous evening, the rezoning had been denied. ✓

Audit. President Childs and Mr. Steinhauer reported on a visit from Mr. John P. Proctor, State Auditor, and Mr. J. V. Connor, Chief Auditor in the State Auditor's Office. An analysis of the audit report submitted by Stone, Gray and Company had been made by Mr. Connor. The meeting was held to discuss this analysis. ✓

It was agreed at this meeting that the School has complied with all requirements of the Auditor's Office and, on the basis of present understandings, the audit of the current year should be acceptable to all concerned.

Health and Accident Plan. Upon motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the name of the student health plan fund was changed to "Health and Accident Fund for the Students of the Colorado School of Mines." ✓

Upon motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the fiscal year and all budgetary records for this fund were changed to July 1 through June 30.

Property Acquisition. Mr. Steinhauer reported that as directed at the last Board meeting, he had prepared an estimate of funds to be available and a tabulation of estimated value of

property not owned by the School in the area of proposed campus expansion. A copy of this listing by Mr. Steinhauer was to be sent to each member of the Board along with copies of the minutes of this meeting.

Property - 1121 Sixteenth Street. Mr. Steinhauer reported on a call from Mr. Criley inquiring if the School would be interested in purchasing the property at 1121 Sixteenth Street. The property had been appraised in 1957 at \$14,800 by Mr. Jack Burt.

It was Mr. Steinhauer's recommendation that nothing be done until we know the amount of money we shall have for property acquisition.

Payment of Vouchers. As a result of the criticisms in the audit report of the slow payment of vouchers, Mr. Steinhauer had inquired of various State officers as to whether the School could make payment prior to Board approval. The Board directed Mr. Steinhauer to obtain a ruling from the Attorney General before any change is made in the method of approval and payment.

Right-to-Lease Legislation. President Childs reported to the Board that he had sent a copy of the proposed legislation, "A Bill for an Act Concerning the Powers of the Board of Trustees of the Colorado School of Mines," to each member of the legislature representing Jefferson County. He reported that Senator Ruth Stockton had agreed to sponsor the bill.

The meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
