Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on May 14, 1965 were approved.

Mr. Steinhauer entered the meeting at this time.

Dormitory Construction. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had contacted Fuller, Fuller, and Fuller, architects, who are now working on site selection and some preliminary sketches.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that a letter agreement be given to the firm of Fuller, Fuller, and Fuller for the work they are now doing and that they be asked to prepare a contract for the entire job for the consideration of the Board.

President Childs asked the Board to consider planning for 500 students to be housed in dormitories. The fact that 450 new students have already shown firm intent to enroll in September shows another 18 to 20 percent increase for next year. This could mean a 44 percent increase in three years.

The members of the Board present were unwilling to approve this without the counsel of the other members.

Property Acquisition for Communications Center Site. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had written to property owners in Blocks 61 and 62, the property between 15th and 16th and Arapahoe and Illinois. He had informed these residents that the School planned to build the Communications Center in two years and asked that the School be allowed to have appraisals made of this property not owned by the School. He had told them that until the property was actually needed arrangements could be made for the present occupants to rent the property from the School, if they so desired.

Representation on Coordinating Council. It was reported that House Bill No. 1170 as passed by the legislature and signed by the Governor provided for an Advisory Committee to the Colorado Commission on Higher Education. The membership of the Advisory Committee provided for one member to be elected by the Board of Trustees of the Colorado School of Mines from its membership.

Mr. Kenneth R. Fenwick was elected by the Board to serve on the Advisory Committee.

Election of Officers. Upon motion made, seconded, and carried, the present slate of officers was retained.

Taxes on Fraternities. President Childs stated that under Senate Bill No. 256 the fraternities have the option to continue the leases now in effect or to accept deeds, according to an opinion received from the Attorney General. If they accept deeds, the taxes will have to be paid but if they continue the leases, the situation is still uncertain.

President Childs has requested Mr. Steinhauer to meet with Mr. David Braden, Jefferson County Assessor, and discuss informally the tax situation on the two existing fraternity houses on School property. In addition, Mr. Fenwick offered to discuss the tax assessment with the County Assessor.

President Childs reported that at the CSM Foundation meeting on June 2, the Board of Directors had voted to reduce the interest on Foundation loans to 6 percent.

Boettcher Proposal. Mr. Steinhauer distributed copies of a letter from Boettcher and Company in which they outlined their recommendations on the refunding of revenue bonds and loans on self-maintaining properties of the School. With respect to the services rendered by Boettcher, it was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the School should employ the Boettcher firm on a consulting basis and the bonds should be put up for bid.

The Board instructed Mr. Steinhauer to inform Boettcher that we would not be able to tell them at this time the extent of the additional dormitory construction planned but the information would be furnished probably within thirty days.

Budget - Associated Students, 1965-66. The budget for the Associated Students for the 1965-66 school year was reviewed.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the budget in the amount of \$25,300 be approved.

Budget - 1965-66 Health and Accident Fund for the Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines. This budget was reviewed.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed, that the budget in the amount of \$37,707 be approved.

Budget - Athletic Association, 1965-66. The budget for the Athletic Association was reviewed.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the budget in the amount of \$39,308 be approved.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer reviewed the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of May 31, 1965; Balance Sheet, May 31, 1965; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of May 31, 1965; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of May 31, 1965; College Union Fund, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of May 29, 1965; Statement of Income and Expense, C.S.M. Dormitory System Revenue Fund, as of May 20, 1965; Statement of Cash Receipts & Expenditures, C.S.M. Self-Maintained Properties, as of May 28, 1965; Office of Research Services, Statement of Cash Receipts & Disbursements, as of May 31, 1965; Dormitory System Revenue Fund, Analysis of Cash Position, May 31, 1965; Athletic Association, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of May 31, 1965; and the Budget Period, Health and Accident Fund for the Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, as of May 29, 1965. The semi-annual report of the student loan funds was also distributed.

College Union Fee. Mr. Steinhauer reported that there had been protests over the charge of the \$5 College Union Fee for the summer six-week field sessions because the students were taking

these courses off campus. The charge had already been made to those registered for the course now in progress.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that after the summer of 1965 no College Union Fee be charged students registered for the six-week field courses. The College Union Fee would continue to be charged students registering in the academic summer session.

Parking Areas. President Childs expressed the desire that some funds be withheld from Mill Levy Building Fund to prepare peripheral parking so that parking could be banned from the center of the campus. The Board approved.

Resident Status - Carl Wayne Winters. President Childs presented a petition for resident status from Carl Wayne Winters forwarded by Mr. Stockmar for consideration at this Board meeting. The Board instructed Mr. Steinhauer to obtain a ruling from the Attorney General on this case.

The meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
