

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Golden, Colorado
January 3, 1966

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Colorado School of Mines was held at 6:00 p.m., January 3, 1966 in the President's Office.

Present: Messrs. Coors, Eisenach, Fenwick, Parker, and Stockmar.

Also present were President Childs and Mr. Steinhauer.

Upon motion by Mr. Fenwick and seconded by Mr. Stockmar, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, that an application be made to the Housing and Home Finance Agency for a loan of \$746,000 for the construction of a new dormitory complex at the Colorado School of Mines. ✓

Mr. Steinhauer stated that he had received a letter from Mrs. Sheila McMahan, mother of the two minor children who are owners of the property at 1005 15th Street, indicating that our offer of \$15,000 for the property was not acceptable to them since there had been another appraisal for this property made by Mr. Dennis Pike in the amount of \$16,550 and that they had received an offer of this amount for this property. ✓

It was moved, seconded, and approved that an offer of \$16,550 be made and, if acceptable, the School enter into a purchase and sale agreement with the McMahans.

There followed a discussion of the sale in the college union of 3.2 beer which had been the subject of numerous informal discussions by the Board at prior meetings. President Childs mentioned that he had discussed this with Governor Love and that the Governor did not care to take a position on the proposal. ✓

Upon motion by Mr. Eisenach, seconded by Mr. Stockmar, and approved, the Board instructed President Childs, as a preliminary to the application for license, to make a study of the practises at other institutions where beer is sold on the campus and further that he appoint a committee to draw up a suggested program of control and operation for the sale of beer. The study and suggested program would then be considered by the Board. ✓

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.

February 12, 1966

The Board of Trustees met in special session on February 12, 1966 at 8:30 a.m., in the President's Office of the Colorado School of Mines.

Present: Messrs. Coors, Eisenach, Fenwick, Parker, and Stockmar.

President Childs attended the meeting.

Dr. Parker, President of the Board, presided.

Beer - College Union. On January 3, 1966 the Board had directed President Childs to make a study and draw up a suggested program of control and operation for the sale of 3.2 beer in the college union.

The Board accepted the report of this study in principle and directed President Childs to proceed with obtaining the license and making necessary plans to accomplish the purpose based upon the report of the feasibility study.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously approved that the Board confirm its earlier determination to provide 3.2 beer in the union which determination was reached when the administration was directed to make its feasibility study.

New Degree Program. It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the following policy statement regarding the new degree program be adopted by the Board:

As a result of its continuing review and study of the joint work of the Graduate Council and the Curricula Committee of the Colorado School of Mines, the Board of Trustees hereby amends and amplifies, as set forth below, the action concerning future degree programs at the Colorado School of Mines taken by it at its August 16, 1965 meeting.

Subject to continuing review and study of the factors necessary to implement the programs, in full recognition that refinements or further amendments thereof may be necessary, and effective only upon acceptance by the Board of the specific curricula required to accomplish them, there is hereby established the following undergraduate degree programs covering engineering studies in the fields of mineral resources and additional programs at the graduate level leading to graduate degrees in engineering and science, again limited to disciplines in mineral resources:

- I. Undergraduate programs leading to undergraduate and advanced degrees.
- A. A four-year program leading to an accredited first degree of Bachelor of Science in Engineering in each presently designated option, requiring approximately 146 semester hours (including any summer work); and
 - B. A five-year program leading to a Professional Degree as a second and advanced degree in each presently designated option, requiring 170-175 semester hours (including any summer work) and which shall include all of the work required under the Bachelor of Science in Engineering program with the first degree of Bachelor of Science in Engineering in that option to be earned simultaneously or en route.
- II. Graduate programs leading to graduate degrees.

From the base of the undergraduate degrees of Bachelor of Science in Engineering, the Graduate School shall continue to administer programs at its present standards, with theses required, leading to degrees in science and engineering at the masters' and doctoral levels.

It is the intent of the Board of Trustees that:


1. The design and programming of undergraduate curricula shall emphasize and give priority to the programs leading to the Professional Degrees or Graduate Degrees; the desired objective being that Colorado School of Mines students shall constantly be encouraged to pursue programs leading to a Professional Degree or to a Graduate Degree;
2. In both undergraduate and advanced programs it is expected that the existing total study load of the students shall not be decreased but that students shall be required to explore in greater depth the subject matter of the courses required;
3. A grade point average of 2.0, as currently determined, shall be required to earn a Bachelor of Science in Engineering Degree;
4. A grade point average of 2.3, as currently determined, shall be required to earn a Professional Degree;
5. Only students earning or meeting all of the requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Engineering Degree at the Colorado School

- of Mines shall qualify for a Professional Degree;
6. Silver diplomas shall be awarded for Professional Degrees and for all Graduate Degrees, and a parchment diploma shall be awarded for a Bachelor of Science in Engineering Degree;
 7. The Professional Degrees to be granted shall consist of the nine named degrees presently granted as the first silver diploma degree; and
 8. Regular students now enrolled shall, insofar as possible and practicable, have the opportunity of completing existing degree programs in line with existing catalog offerings.

Among other recommendations from the joint meeting of the Curricula Committee and the Graduate Council was the recommendation that certain departments should be allowed to grant a first degree of Bachelor of Science in Science with a designated option.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that the degree Bachelor of Science in Science not be given at this time.

The meeting adjourned at 3:30 p.m.

Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meetings held on December 10, 1965 and January 3, 1966 were approved.

New Degree Program. After some discussion with regard to the new degree program, it was requested that the insert which had been placed in the current catalog describing the program be changed before it becomes a page in the reissue of the catalog.

President Childs' Australian Trip. The Board was informed of the invitation extended to President Childs from the Australian Petroleum Exploration Association to address their national meeting in Brisbane on March 13 at the expense of the Association. In connection with this trip, visits to the universities at Queensland, Canberra, and South Wales were described for the purpose of exploring the feasible relationships with the Colorado School of Mines.

The Board expressed agreement about the advantages to be derived from this trip and authorized President Childs to go ahead with the planned itinerary.

CSM Foundation Board. President Childs stated that he felt that Mr. Thomas' appointment to the CSM Foundation Board as a representative of the Colorado School of Mines Board should be reconfirmed as a matter of courtesy to Mr. Thomas.

The Board unanimously approved this confirmation of appointment.

Dean Jordan's Request for Academic Leave. President Childs presented a request from Dean Jordan for an academic leave for the first semester of the 1966-67 school year. Dean Jordan is requesting the leave so that he may spend the time in a study of graduate education at other institutions. Dean Kuhn recommended, and President Childs concurred, that Dean Jordan be granted this leave at three-quarters of his regular salary.

The Board approved this request.

Architect's Proposal - New Humanities Center. President Childs reported that upon his request the firm of Ken R. White Company had submitted a proposal to proceed with further planning of the humanities center. As proposed by the Ken R. White firm, the next drawings would represent approximately 25 percent of the architectural and engineering services required for the project. Based on a project construction cost of \$2,500,000 and an architectural fee of 6 percent, the fee for these next drawings would be \$37,500, less the amount of \$5,000, the fee for the schematic plans, concept design folio and model, previously paid.

The Board approved the proposal, subject to State approval.

New Savings Account. Upon motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the funds of the Colorado School of Mines Simon Guggenheim Fund be and the same are hereby authorized to be added to or paid into a savings account

in the Englewood Savings and Loan Association and that said institution be and it is hereby authorized to pay withdrawals until further written notice to it signed in the name of this organization by Gurnett Steinhauer, Treasurer, and Orlo E. Childs, President. Said institution further is authorized to accept a pledge of all or any part of said account as security for any loan made by it to said organization and executed in its name by the signatory parties indicated in the preceding sentence. Said institution is authorized to supply any endorsement for the Colorado School of Mines Simon Guggenheim Fund on any check or other instrument tendered for this account and it is hereby relieved of any liability in connection with collection of such items which are handled by it without negligence and it shall not be made on account of such items until collected, and any amount not collected may be charged back to this account, including expense incurred, and any other outside expense incurred on account of this account may be charged to it.

New Faculty Appointments. President Childs reviewed for the Board the new appointments to the faculty. The Board approved the following appointments:

U. S. Bureau of Reclamation Agreement. President Childs presented an agreement which had been drawn up by the Bureau of Reclamation which would allow a graduate student, Lynn Brown, to install load cells in the Divide Tunnel as part of research for his graduate work.

On motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, the document was approved for signature.

Beer - College Union. President Childs distributed copies of a report, with recommendations, made by the committee which he had appointed. Consideration of the recommendations was postponed until another meeting.

Easement Requested by U. S. Bureau of Reclamation. Mr. Steinhauer reported that the Bureau of Reclamation had asked for a 125 foot easement across a portion of our property at Wild Horse Park to provide a transmission line. The area they wish to cross is not a part of the property being acquired by the U. S. Army of Engineers.

It was the opinion of the members of the Board that we should first determine whether the School had the right to grant such an easement.

Fraternity House Contraction - HHFA Funds. Mr. Steinhauer reported that as instructed at the December Board meeting he had

The Board approved this additional endorsement to the present policy.

Sudler Claim for Additional Fees. Mr. Stockmar reviewed the items for which Mr. Sudler was making additional claim. It was generally agreed that the claim was not a valid claim and Mr. Stockmar agreed to meet with Mr. Sudler's attorney to inform him.

Commencement Speaker. President Childs reported that Mr. Frank R. Milliken, President of Kennecott Copper Corporation, had accepted his invitation to give the Commencement speech.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that Mr. Milliken be awarded an honorary degree.

The meeting adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
