Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meetings held on February 7 and February 12, 1966 were approved.

Mr. Steinhauer entered the meeting at this time.

3.2 Beer License. It was moved, seconded, and unanimously approved that an attorney be employed to handle the license application and that the cost of the legal fees be taken from college union funds.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer reviewed the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 28, 1966; Balance Sheet, February 28, 1966; Restricted Funds, February 28, 1966; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of February 28, 1966; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of February 28, 1966; Statement of Income and Expense, Mines Park Addition and Houses No. 1, as of February 28, 1966; Statement of Income and Expense, Houses No. 2, as of February 28, 1966; Analysis of Cash Position, Operations Pledged to Open End Bond Issue, through February 28, 1966; C.S.M. Athletic Association, Comparison of Receipts and Disbursements to Budget, as of February 28, 1966; Budget Period, Health and Accident Fund for the Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, as of February 28, 1966; and the Graduate Research Center, Statement of Income and Expense, as of February 28, 1966.

Earthquake Study Appropriation. Mr. Steinhauer reported that the request for an appropriation of \$121,950 for a proposed study of earthquakes in the Denver area had been allowed by the legislature. The members of the Board were of the opinion that President Childs should confer with Governor Love with respect to the use of this appropriation.

Waltman Fund. Mr. Steinhauer reported on the William D. Waltman gift of Standard Oil of New Jersey stock which Mr. Waltman had given for the purpose of setting up a Commencement prize. In the original terms set up by Mr. Waltman, this stock was to be held in perpetual trust by the Board of Trustees of the School and the annual dividend income on this stock was to be awarded as a prize at Commencement. Dr. Parker stated that in conversations Mr. Waltman indicated that he felt this stock was a good investment and should be held.

Mr. Steinhauer was instructed to notify the Denver United States National Bank that the Standard Oil of New Jersey securities given by Mr. Waltman should not be made a part of the Colorado School of Mines endowment funds.

Experimental Plant Deficit. Mr. Steinhauer reported that the allocation for the "Mineral Industries Bulletin" in the Experimental Plant Fund had been over-expended for the 1965-66 fiscal year and that it might be necessary to suspend publication of the Bulletin during the balance of this period. The Board requested that President Childs and Mr. Steinhauer confer with Mr. Crabtree concerning this deficit and that an effort be made to reduce the overhead charge by the CSM Research Foundation on this project.

Dormitory Construction. Mr. Steinhauer reported that the Housing and Home Finance Agency (now the Department of Housing and Urban Development) was concerned that we had not lived up to the covenants of the present agreement in that we have not had a yearly audit. Mr. Steinhauer had explained to them that as a state institution we had to depend upon the State Auditor's office to do this at a time of their own scheduling. He stated that we may have to hire a private auditing firm to audit the self-maintaining property before a loan agreement for the new dormitory complex can be prepared.

Mr. Steinhauer reported that there was an immediate need to establish an open loan for processing the construction and architectural costs for the dormitory complex.

On motion made, seconded, and unanimously passed, Mr. Steinhauer was authorized to borrow at the best possible interest rate from either the Denver United States National Bank or the Colorado National Bank an amount up to \$750,000 on an open end basis as required for our dormitory construction fund.

Property Acquisition. Mr. Steinhauer reviewed the land acquisition schedule. There was a total of \$222,457 available and Mr. Steinhauer itemized the properties which the School desired to acquire. He listed the Green property at the corner of 19th and Illinois which had been purchased with CSM Foundation funds. He stated he thought it would be proper for the School to purchase this at this time from the Foundation and the Board approved this transaction.

The Board gave general approval for Mr. Steinhauer's property acquisition schedule.

Easement - Wild Horse Park. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had directed an inquiry to the Attorney General's office to determine whether the School had the power to grant an easement. The Attorney General's staff had advised that the School did have such right and Mr. Steinhauer said he was waiting for the papers to arrive for Board signature.

Mr. Steinhauer left the meeting at this time.

Previous Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on March 11, 1966 were approved.

Degree Program - Catalog Statement. A statement describing the new degree program for insertion in the catalog was approved.

Service Pins for Faculty. The Board approved in principle a recommendation made by the Administrative Advisory Council that faculty members be awarded service pins for certain years of service and suggested further study of the pin design.

Leave of Absence - Ramon E. Bisque. President Childs reported on a request made by Dr. Ramon E. Bisque for a second year's leave of absence in order that Dr. Bisque could complete his work as Director of the American Geological Institute's Earth Science Curriculum Project.

The Board approved the extension of leave.

Athletic Department Staff. President Childs reported that an additional staff member was being added to the Athletic Department in view of increased enrollment. He further reported that Coach Brennecke had expressed a desire to turn over the head football coaching assignment to another staff member and retain his position as Director of Athletics and baseball coach.

The Board approved the change of staff within the Athletic Department and authorized the administration to proceed with such change by working with the alumni in selection of a football coach.

Foreign Students - Cost of Education. President Childs reported that on trips to Washington he had contacted the State Department in an attempt to secure some cost-of-education supplement for foreign students enrolled at the Colorado School of Mines. He also reported that he had contacted the Colorado senators in an effort to explore possibilities of channeling some federal foreign aid funds into this cause. He had been informed that there was at present no mechanism by which this could be done. He was informed that there was a bill in committee now in the House which may activate such a thing.

President Childs reported that the alternative would be to increase tuition for foreign students. The members of the Board were of the opinion that there really was no more justification to increase tuition for foreign students than there was for out-of-state students. It was the opinion of the members of the Board that the enrollment of foreign students at the School had contributed greatly to the School and to the State of Colorado.

Monthly Reports. Mr. Steinhauer reviewed the monthly reports as follows: Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of March 31, 1966; Balance Sheet, March 31, 1966; Restricted Funds, March 31, 1966; Restricted Funds, March 31, 1966; Mill Levy Building Fund, as of March 31, 1966; Experimental Plant, Summary of Budget Appropriation & Disbursements, as of March 31, 1966; Statement of

Income and Expense, Mines Park Addition and Houses No. 1, as of March 31, 1966; Statement of Income and Expense, Houses No. 2, as of March 31, 1966; Analysis of cash Position, Operations Pledged to Open End Bond Issue, July 1, 1965 through March 31, 1966; C.S.N. Athletic Association, Comparison of Receipts and Disbursements to Budget, as of March 31, 1966; Budget Period, Health and Accident Fund for the Associated Students of the Colorado School of Mines, as of March 31, 1966; and the Statement of Income and Expense, Graduate Research Center, as of March 31, 1966.

Fraternity Houses. President Childs read a letter dated March 26, 1966 from Mr. Gary W. Hudiburgh, attorney for the Kappa Sigma Association and the Crucible Fraternal Association (Beta), in which he stated that both corporations were prepared to accept warranty deeds for their sites on the west campus.

Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had obtained a master title insurance policy for the entire area and could issue title policies for each site. The Board approved the granting of warranty deeds on the individual sites.

President Childs reported that Mr. Hudiburgh had received a letter from the County Assessor, Mr. Dave Braden, in which Mr. Braden had agreed to accept taxes on the Beta house and the Kappa Sigma house for 1963, 1964, and 1965 on the assessed valuation of their respective houses as of 1962. Mr. Braden had also agreed to assess taxes beginning in 1966 at the 60 percent maximum depreciation.

Bequest - Laura Walker Wolf. President Childs reported on a bequest of securities in the amount of \$61,105 from the late Mrs. Albert G. Wolf. Mr. Steinhauer reported that these securities would be put in the CSM Foundation account at the Denver United States National.

Application for 3.2 Beer License. Mr. Steinhauer reported that he had retained Mr. Lyle Miller to handle the application for a 3.2 beer license for the college union. Mr. Miller had suggested that a separate nonprofit corporation be set up to act as agent for the handling of the 3.2 beer license and service. The Board felt that final responsibility for the administration of the new practise should rest with the Board.
