Between 1995 and 2013, she held positions of increasing responsibility in the areas of exploration, Reservoir Management, Finance, and Business Planning and worked on projects in Venezuela, Angola, and the San Joaquin Valley and the Permian Basin in the United States. She is a member of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists ad the Society of Petroleum Engineers.
